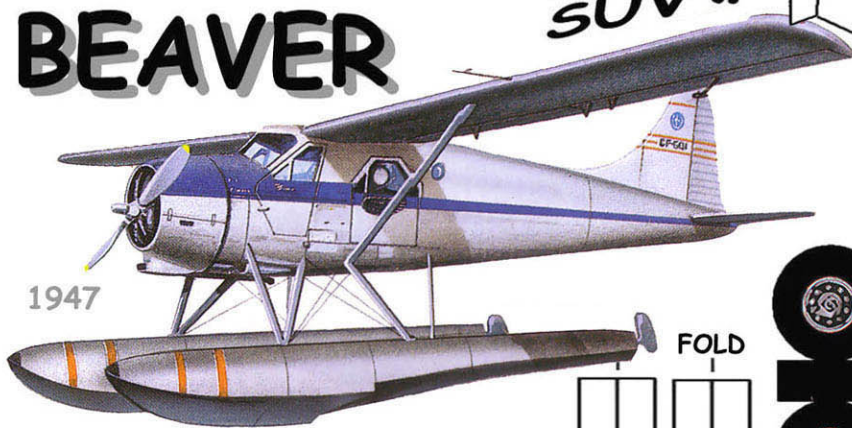


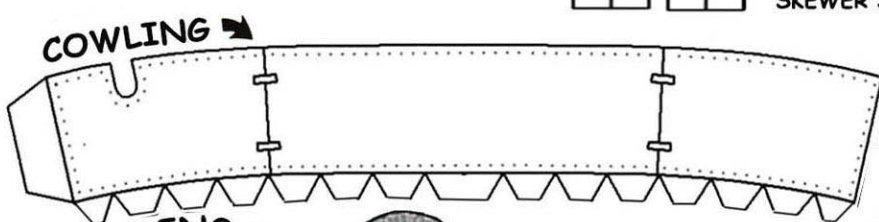
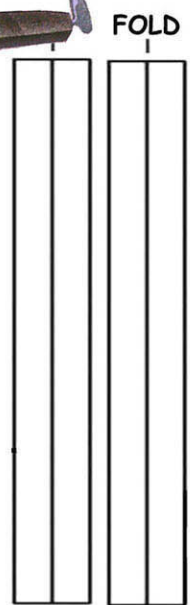
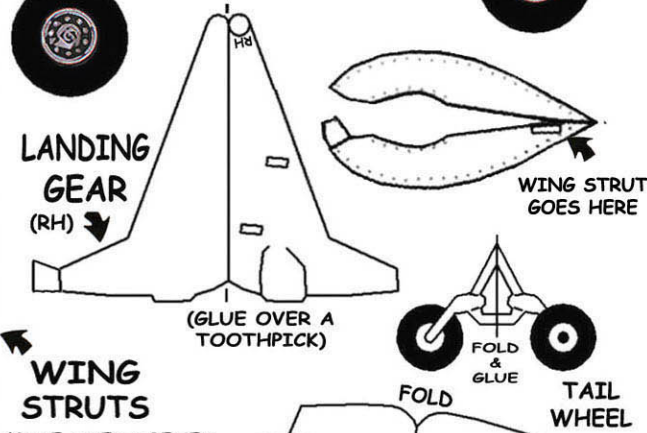
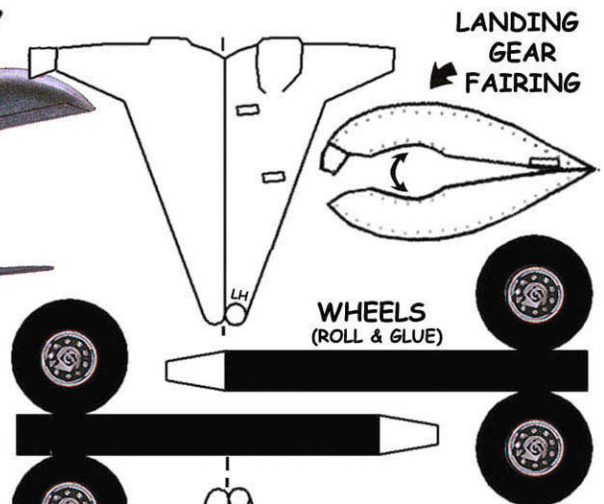
# DHC-2 DeHavilland BEAVER

THE ULTIMATE SUV!!

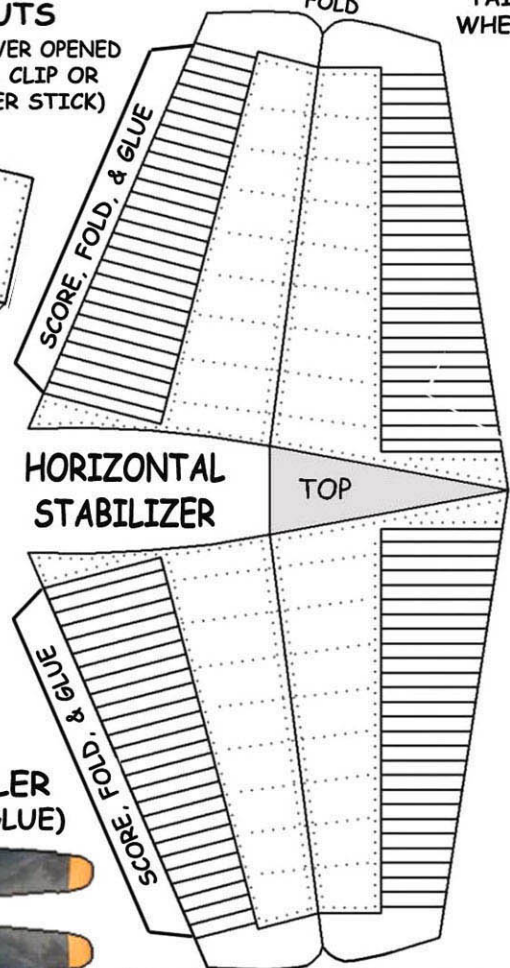
